[D] I wanna play with [G] my ding-a-ling-a-ling [D] [G]

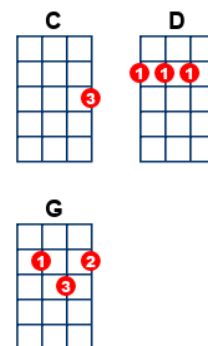
[G] Humpty Dumpty [C] on the wall,
